# THE COMPANY STRUCTURE

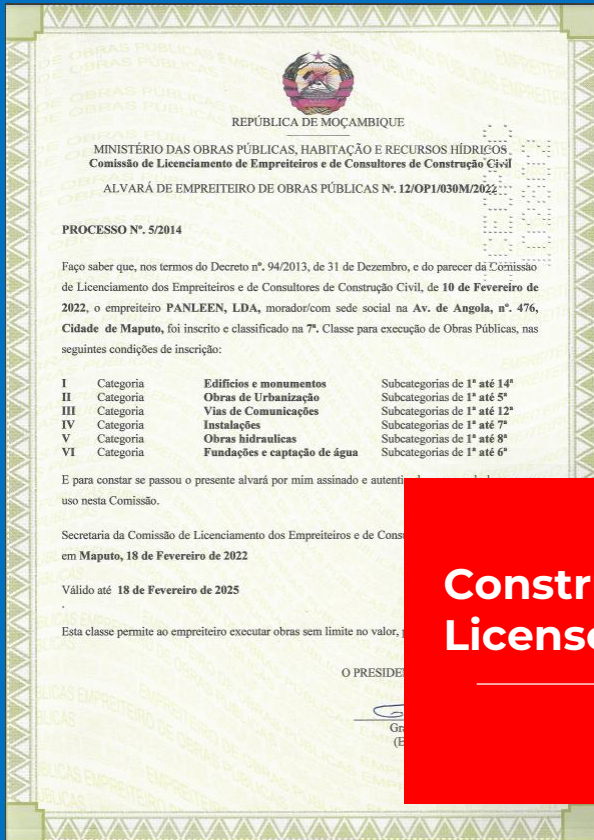
